# SAFEGUARDING REQUIREMENTS

## SAFEGUARDING CODE OF CONDUCT

Establishes clear expectations for appropriate behaviour with children and young people. All clergy, employees and volunteers engaged in parish ministry in the Catholic Archdiocese of Melbourne need to comply with the Code of Conduct.

#### **ACTION**

- Read and agree to abide by the <u>Safeguarding Code of Conduct</u> <u>Declaration</u>.
- Seek clarification if needed.

### **WORKING WITH CHILDREN CHECK**

Is a screening process for assessing or re-assessing people who work with or care for children and vulnerable adults. All clergy, employees and volunteers in parish ministry in the Catholic Archdiocese of Melbourne are required to have a current check.
